

Hello All,

Please consider responding to one (or more) of the following writing prompts by Sunday, July 30th, 2023:

- 1. The Title Page of the Book of Mormon states one of the purposes of the Book of Mormon is, "to the convincing of the Jew and Gentile that Jesus is the Christ, the Eternal God." How has the Book of Mormon strengthened your testimony that Jesus is the Christ?
- 2. President Ezra Taft Benson said, "the third reason why the Book of Mormon is of such value to Latter-Day Saints is given in the same statement by the prophet Joseph Smith cited previously. He said, 'I told the brethren that the Book of Mormon was the most correct of any book on earth, and the keystone of our

religion, and a man would get nearer to God by abiding by its precepts, than by any other book' (*History of the Church*, 4:461). That is the third reason for studying the book. It helps us draw nearer to God. Is there not something deep in our hearts that longs to draw nearer to God, to be more like Him in our daily walk, to feel His presence with us constantly? If so, then the Book of Mormon will help us do so more than any other book." *How have the principles taught in the Book of Mormon helped you draw nearer to God? How has abiding by its precepts helped you to feel His presence in your daily life?*
