












### Level Position

  - My Calling
- Figure out mtg schedules & outline your responsibilities
- Figure out how to fit the new responsibilities into your already busy lifestyle.
- Speak with the past person in calling to collect "tribal knowledge" & "tricks of the trade".
- Seek training from the stake- every calling has its support person at the stake level.
  - ie.: Ward Mission Leaders Karl Watts HC over Missionary Work

- Be intentional
- Be with them (Sundays / Weeknight / Monthly camp outs / summer camp / service
- Learn names: Get to know others and let them get to know you
- All Means All- Get to know everyone.
- How am I going to make a personal connection with each?
  - Ministering
  - Ministering interviews
  - Social engagements
    - minute to win it / game nights/ Pie nights
- Look for ways to make personal connections especially with those on the fringes or less active
  - Go to their football games / track meets / ROTC events
  - Go where they are.
